

ORDINANCE OF THE MINISTER OF HEALTH

on the list of healthcare services requiring prior authorisation

The list of healthcare services, for which reimbursement of costs, referred to in Article 42b (1) of the Act of 27 August 2004 on healthcare services financed from public funds, requires prior authorisation of the head of the regional branch of the National Health Fund, referred to in Article 42b (9) of this Act

- overnight hospital accommodation of the patient for at least one night, regardless of the type of the services provided;
- treatment within the drug programmes referred to in the Act of 12 May 2011 on reimbursement of medicines, foodstuffs intended particular nutritional uses and medical devices (Journal of Laws No. 122, item 696, as amended);
- isotope therapy;
- stereotactic radiation therapy;
- proton beam radiation therapy;
- hyperbaric oxygen therapy;
- implantation of baclofen pump in the treatment of drug-resistant spasticity;
- genetic testing;
- positron emission tomography;
- nuclear medicine testing.

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
